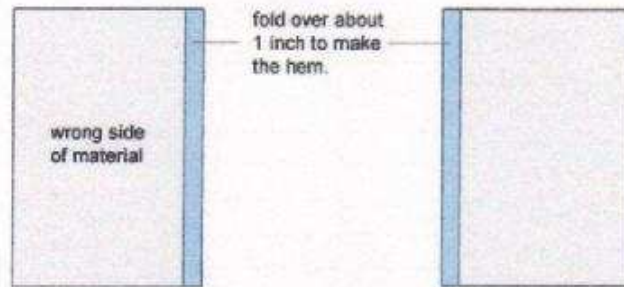
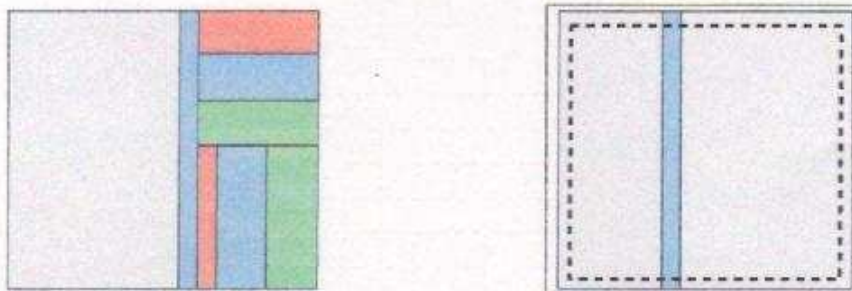


On each of the back pieces, hem one of the 12.1/2 inch sides. (Turn in about an inch to do this.)



Place one piece of the backing on top of the front, right side together.

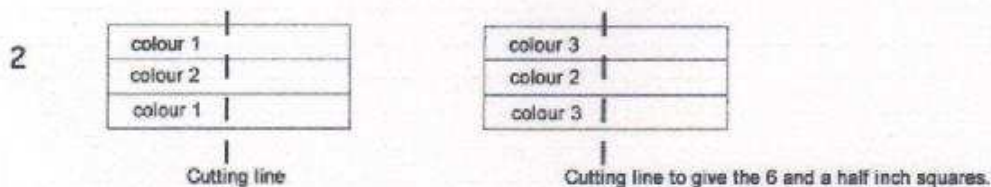


Place the second piece of backing on top, over lapping the first piece. Again matching the outer edges of the front panel. (The overlap should be about four to four and a half inches depending on how wide you make the hem.)

Stitch all round the outside edge. (Dotted line.) Trim the corners and turn to the right side through the opening in the middle.

Finally ease in your 12 inch square cushion insert into the finished cover.

NB. Different patterns can be made by joining the strips in different ways.



Cut the strips 13 inches long so that there are two strips of each colour.
