

Curved patch cushion



9" = 25cm

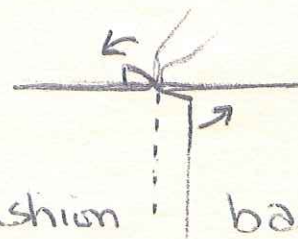
7" = 18cm

- Cut 4 x 9" squares for the background.
- Cut 3 x 7" squares for the contrast (flower)
- Draw 3 circles 7" diameter on the paper side of some Bondaweb.
- Iron the 3 bondaweb circles on to the wrong side of your contrasting (flower) fabric
- Cut out the 3 circles of fabric neatly
- Now peel off the paper + press down onto 3 of your 9" squares.

Your kit contains all of the above. ↑

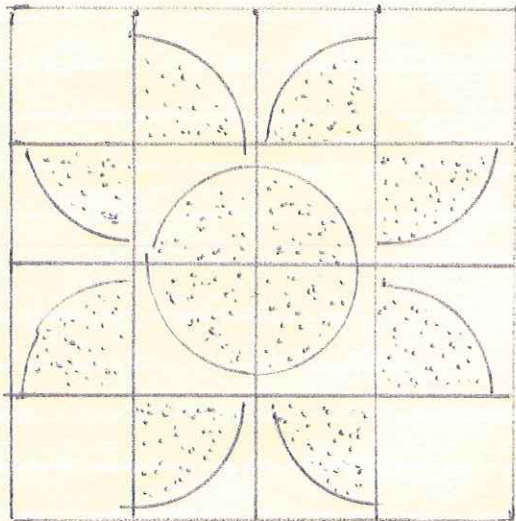
Method

1. Set your machine to a zig-zag stitch + sew round 3 complete circles - be slow and steady.
2. Cut your circle on the square into 4 equal squares. You can use a pencil + ruler or you can fold + press before you cut with scissors. Do the same to all 3.
3.  Now you arrange the small squares to form a flower - (or whatever design you prefer.)
4. Lay out your design in 4 rows. Pin the squares of row 1 together + sew by machine using a straight stitch. Then do the same for rows 2, 3, + 4. 
5. Now pin row 1 to row 2 + stitch
row 2 to row 3 + stitch
+ row 3 to row 4 + stitch
6. Push the seams so they lay flat
7. Press to complete and attach a cushion back.

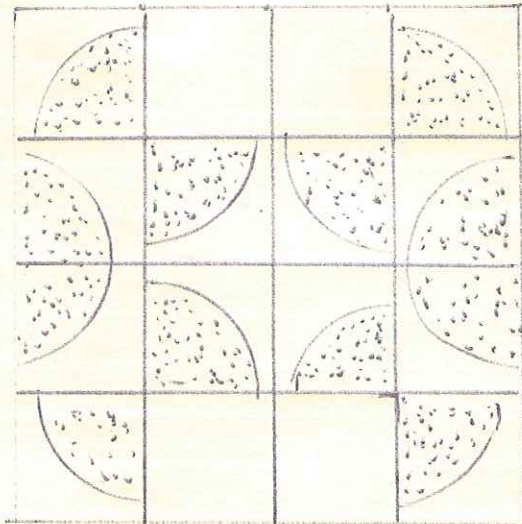


16-patch (16" BLOCK)

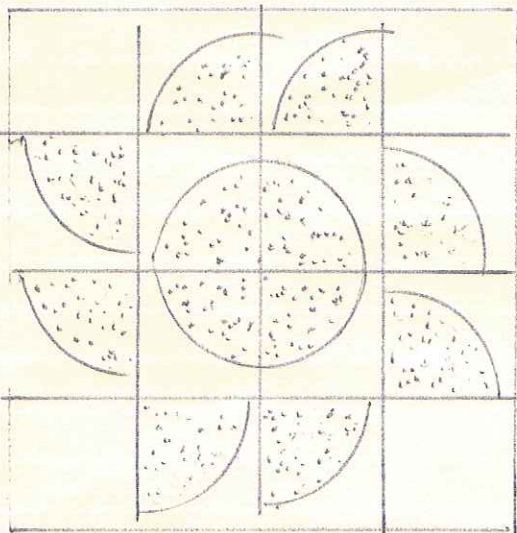

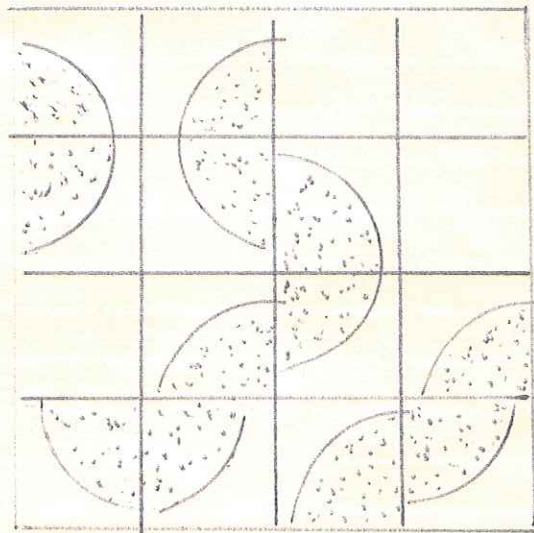

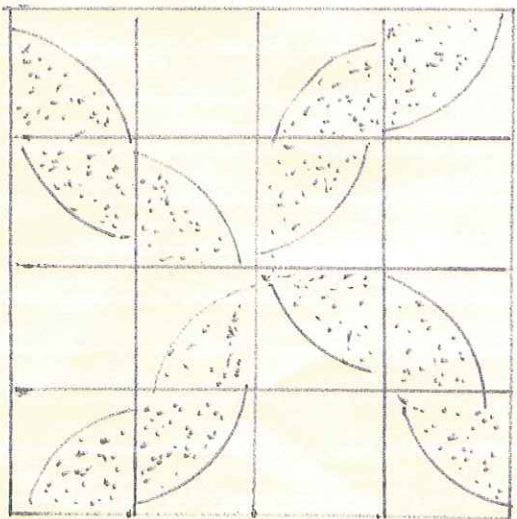
