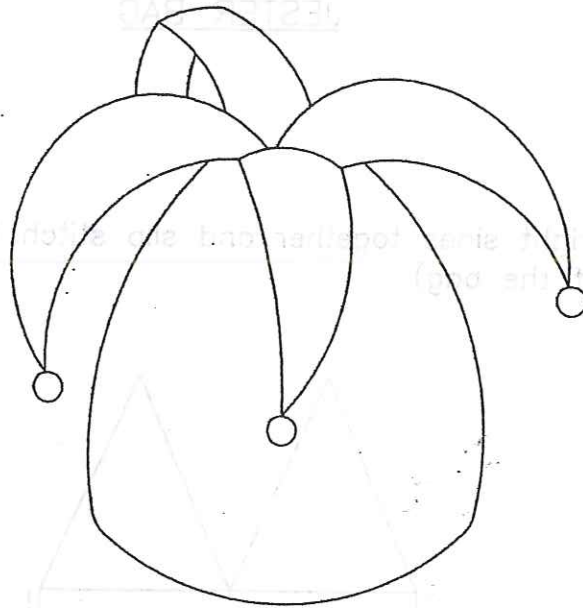


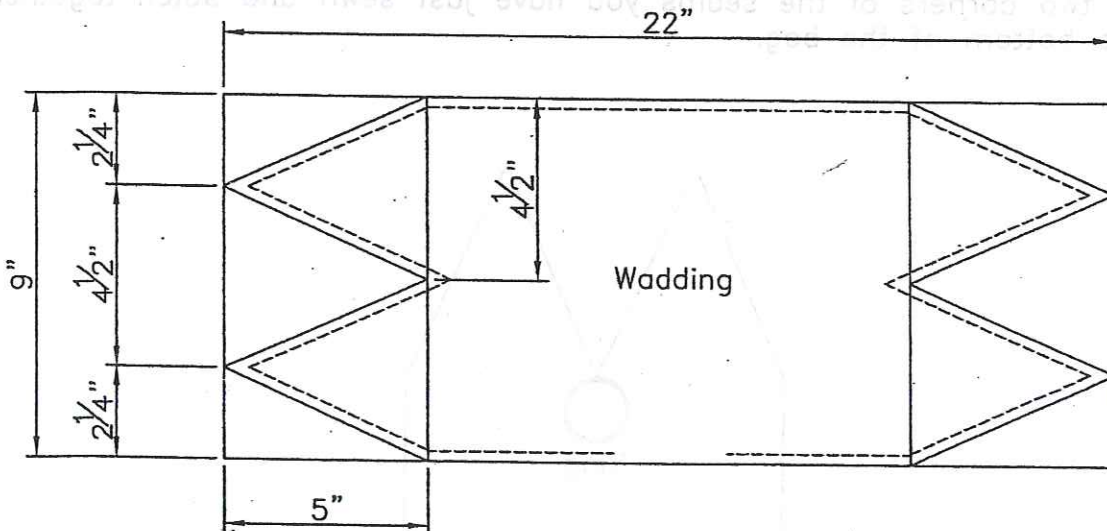
JESTER BAG



You will need:

- 2 pieces of fabric, each measuring 22" x 9", cut from two different fabrics.
- 1 piece of wadding (not too thick - cotton wadding is ideal) 12" x 9".
- 4 large bells.
- 1 large brass curtain ring.
- Matching cotton thread.

- 1) On the wrong side of one piece of fabric, measure 5" in from each end - draw a line. Divide up each end, as shown below.



Now place this marked fabric on top of a second piece of fabric, right sides together. Place the wadding in the centre.

- 2) Next, machine stitch with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ ", as indicated by the dotted line. Remember to leave a gap for turning.

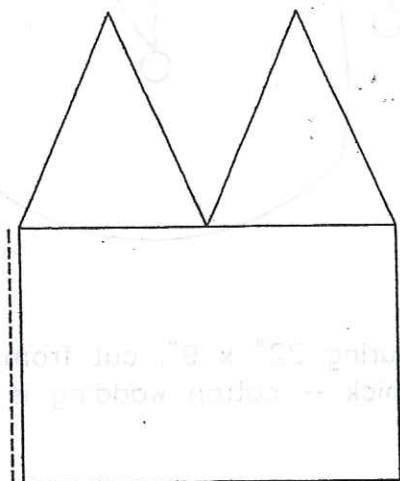
Before turning, trim the points and cut away excess fabric.

Turn right sides out.

- 3) Stitch up the hole.

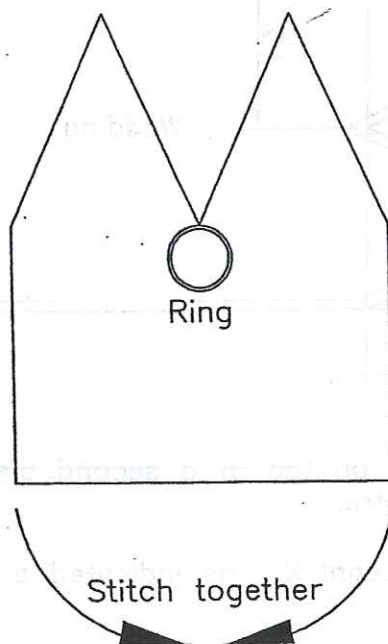

- 4 Next, fold the bag with right sides together and slip stitch the side seams together (this will be the inside of the bag).



Turn, so the stitching is inside the bag.

- 5 Lastly, take the two corners of the seams you have just sewn and stitch together to form the square bottom of the bag.



- 6 Finally, attach a bell to each point and the ring between two points.
