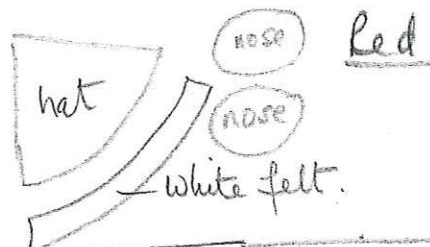
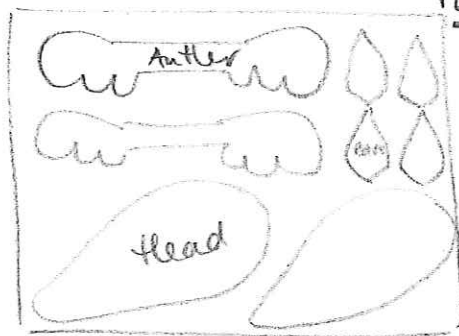







# Rudolph

Fawn



- 2 antler pieces
- 2 head pieces
- 4 ear pieces

- Fawn felt.
- Red felt.
- White felt.
- Wadding for stuffing.
- Brown + Black embroidery thread.

1. Cut out 2 head shapes. Machine all around 
2. Make a slit 3cm long in lower part of head and turn inside out. Stuff and close slit.
3. Stitch around 2 nose pieces.  Slit and stuff lightly. Stitch to face covering head slit.
4. Add backstitch mouth in black.
5. Cut four ear pieces and stitch around in pairs, leaving small gap at bottom to stuff lightly. 
6. Make antlers. Cut out one antler and place onto fabric of equal size.  Pin and stitch around - leaving a gap at bottom. Cut stuff lightly up into antlers, and along centre part. Continue stitching and close gap. 
7. Stitch antlers to hat. Place on reindeer and position eyes and ears. Stitch in place.
8. Add bell to hat and fix to head.
9. Add hanging ribbon / or felt strip to hat.
10. Blush his cheeks with crayon.
