

Rick Rack Easter Egg



Requirements:

2 pieces of egg-shaped felt (cut out of A4)
Slightly smaller piece of wadding
Strips of patterned fabric, 1 inch longer than width of egg
Strips of rickrack or decorative ribbon
Slim ribbon or cord for hanging
Buttons, beads, felt flowers as desired

Glue pen, sewing machine, needle and thick thread for finishing

Taking one egg, glue strips of fabric where desired, allowing at least half inch overhang on each side. Glue rickrack so that it covers the raw edges of the fabric, again with an overhang of at least half an inch. Turn loose ends under and glue in place. Secure with machine stitching.

Fold slim ribbon in half and pin loop to top centre of decorated egg. Place wadding on remaining egg piece. Put two pieces of egg together with wadding inside, glue round edges and stitch. It could be just a running stitch, blanket stitch, or something else (or top-stitched by machine if hand stitching would be too difficult.)

Decorate with flower and button if desired.
