The Quilters' Guild: joining by Direct Debit

DIRECT DEBIT FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Please complete **ALL** parts of the form in ball point pen. *We cannot accept photocopies or forms that have been amended with Tippex or crossing out.*

Please ensure that:

- If you are already a member, that you provide your name and membership number
- If this is a new membership, you fill in your name and address details
- If you are paying for a membership for someone else (e.g. as a gift or for a Young Quilter) please ensure you complete **both** name and address boxes, as the subscription reminder will be sent to the person paying the Direct Debit
- You are clear which parts of your membership subscription you would like to be included in your Direct Debit.
- You have confirmed your preferred frequency of payments (annual or quarterly)
- You provide all the required information regarding your bank and your bank account
- You have signed AND dated the form.
- Please do not write outside the boxes
- Please do not write anything in the Reference boxes
- **The Guild collects Direct Debits on the 1st of each month. Forms must be returned by the 12th of the month before the Direct Debit is due.**

Please note: If you have joined a specialist group and paid for it by cash, cheque, online, etc., we cannot automatically add this to your Direct Debit instruction. You will need to complete and return a new Direct Debit form that confirms everything you want to be included on your Direct Debit.

If any part of the form is incorrect we will not be able to set up your Direct Debit and will need to return the form to you for completion. We are not allowed to make any changes on your behalf.

Once we have set up the Direct Debit we will write to you with 10 working days' notice confirming when the payments are due.

You can cancel your Direct Debit at any time – please do this with your bank and please advise us that you have done so.

The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, The Quilters' Guild will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request The Quilters' Guild to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The Quilters' Guild or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
 - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when The Quilters' Guild asks you to
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
