

Spring decorations - Rooster




You can sew this project by hand.

You will need: Felt (two different colours) Scissors Template sheet Pencil Needle and thread

Cotton balls for filling

Thimble





TIP: Instead of felt you can use any solid or patterned cotton fabric




2. Glue the goggle eyes and the wings (different colour to different body) onto each body of the rooster.

 Cut out two bodies and two wings from different colour/ fabric.



4. Sew the roosters together, but leave about 3-4 cm of opening, keep the needle with thread.

 Use the opening to fill in the rooster with cotton balls rearrange it so it stays nicely even.



7. Sew a handle onto the finished rooster and you are done.



6. Close the opening by stitching it, when you finish make a knot and cut off the remaining thread.
