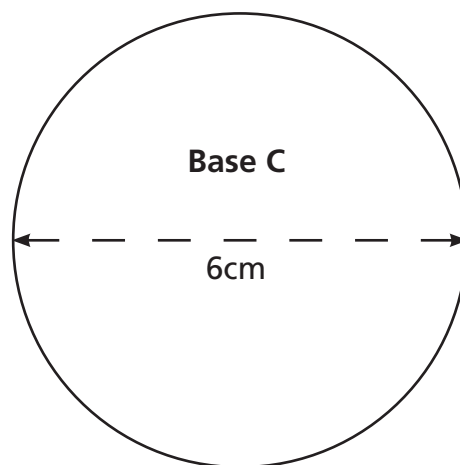
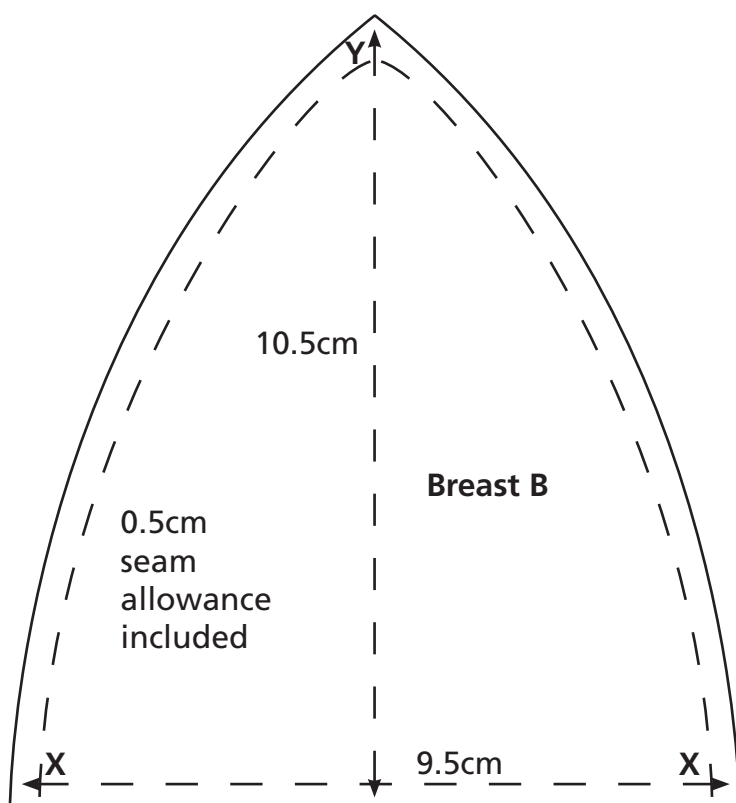
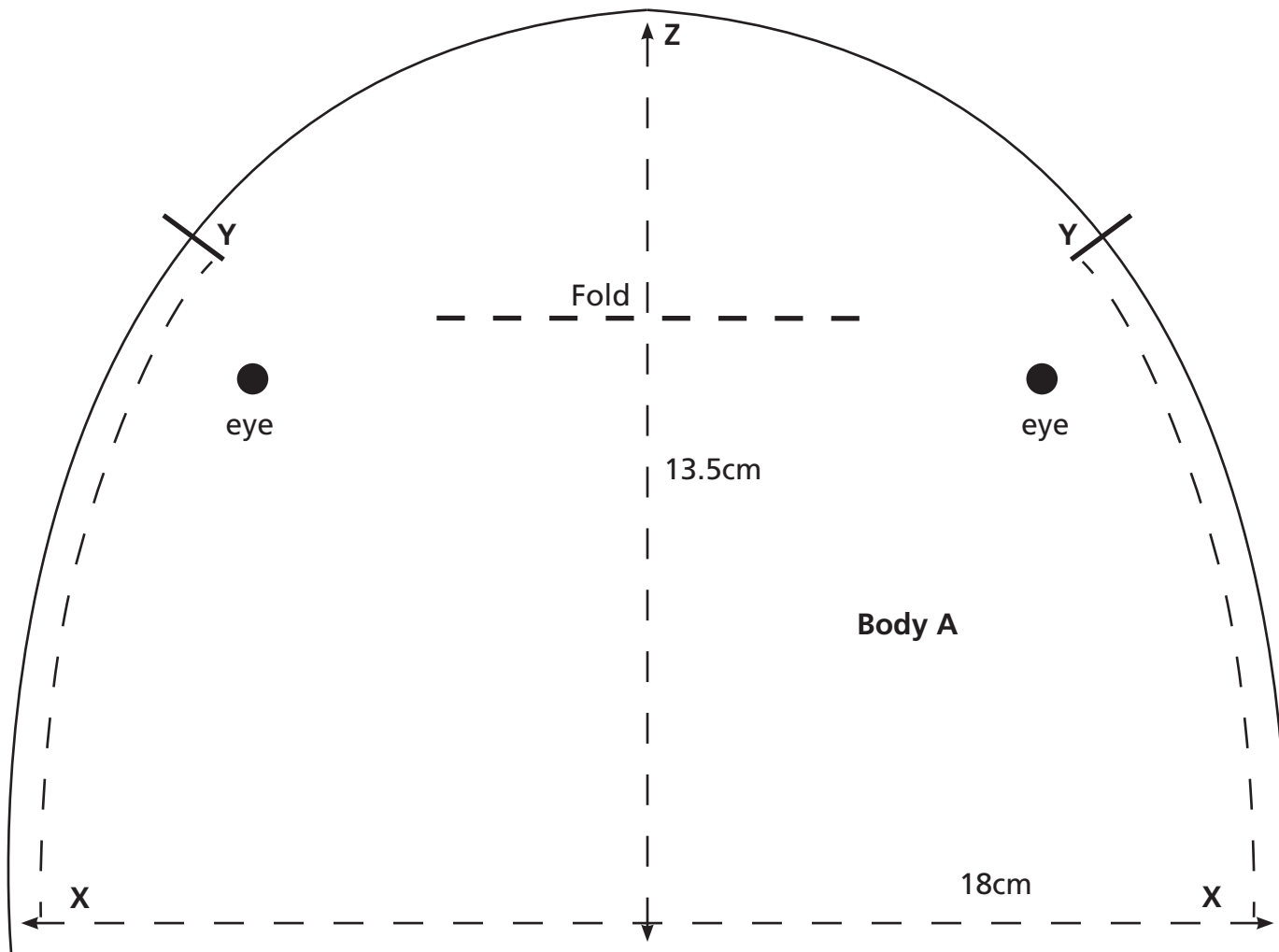


# Pattern pieces for Owl Project



# How to make your owl

## You will need ...

- Scraps of fabric:  
Body A 19.5 x 15.0cm  
Breast B 12.0 x 11.0cm  
Base C 7.5cm square
- Sewing thread and needle
- Beads or buttons for eyes
- Stuffing

## Instructions

- 1 Transfer the pattern pieces onto card or thick paper to make templates. At the same time cut out a circle of card with a diameter of 4cm.
- 2 From the fabrics cut one Body A, one Breast B and one Base C. On Body A mark all points X, Y and Z, the fold line and the position of the eyes. On Breast B mark all points X and Y.
- 3 With right sides together, sew Breast B to Body A at each side from X to Y, starting at X. Press each seam.
- 4 Folding Body A right sides together, match points Y. Sew the seam between Y and Z.
- 5 Turn your owl right side out, pushing out the 'beak' at Z. Fold the beak over and stitch it down onto the breast.
- 6 Stitch on buttons or beads for eyes at the points marked.
- 7 Stuff the owl from the base until firm.
- 8 Run a gathering stitch around the bottom of the Body. Pull up to close, and tie off the thread.
- 9 Run a gathering stitch around the Base fabric. Insert the 4cm circle of card (on reverse side of fabric), pull fabric around it and tie off the thread.
- 10 Stitch the Base to the bottom of the Body.
- 11 Name your owl!
