

## **Christmas Penguin**

## Order of work:

- 1. Cut out paper penguin shape.
- 2. Draw around it onto black fabric, using a white/chalk pencil.
- 3. Cut out paper 'breast shape' and use it to draw around onto Bonda web and cut this out carefully.
- 4. Iron this onto wrong side of white fabric.
- 5. Cut out carefully and peel off backing.
- 6. Iron on to the penguin body, checking position with paper pattern.
- 7. Stitch using white thread and even stitches.
- 8. Add eyes using beads, felt nose & pink checks.
- 9. Pin penguin paper pattern to wrong side of fabric, checking position now pin to penguin black 'back'.
- 10. Carefully stitch all around penguin, leaving a gap at the base.
- 11. Trim back to stitch line and 'snip' the curves and into corners carefully.
- 12. Stuff with wadding, pushing into the arms, add a small bag of gravel and stitch across base.
- 13. Fold in corners so that he can stand.
- 14. Add buttons for ear muffs.
- 15. Felt feet are made from doubled orange felt, glued and stitched and glued to base.
- 16. Cut fabric for scarf 60cm long and 14cm wide.
