

Felt Christmas Tree Ornaments

You Will Need - Two 10cm squares of red felt, one 9cm square of white felt, 20cm of thin ribbon, sequins/beads, matching/contrasting thread and needle, scissors

Instructions:-



Draw around a mug (with a diameter of about 8cm) onto felt. Make two circles approximately 1cm diameter and cut them out on the line.



Fold a red circle in half and cut out a heart shape. You can practise this on paper first. Place on top of the white felt square. Using a running stitch sew around the outer edge of the heart on the red felt. Cut off excess white felt making sure you don't cut near your stitches. You should not see any white felt around the edge of the red circle now.



Stitch round white heart in the centre with red thread and a running stitch. Sew sequins or beads round the heart (optional). Fold the 20cm of ribbon in half and using small stitched attach to back of heart.



Place second red circle onto back of the decoration and sew round them both using a running stitch or a blanket stitch. Enjoy your ornament.

How to make you ornament individual

You could change the colour or size of the ornament.

You could use a different shape in the centre, for example a circle or Christmas Tree.

You could make two or three and hang them together

Just let your imagination run away with you!
