Patchwork Heart

This project could be adapted to make a Mother's Day or Valentine's wall-hanging, card or cushion.

Requirements

As well as your basic sewing kit you will need;

- Fourteen squares from a selection of fabrics; each square is 2½" x 2½"
 (6½ cm x 6½ cm)
- Backing fabric approximately 12" x 12" (30½ cm x 30½ cm)
- A slightly larger piece of wadding
- Four 3" (7½ cm) strips cut to backing length
- Sewing and embroidery threads
- Buttons

To make the heart

- 1. Sew the squares together, firstly in pairs and then into three rows of four, plus two.
- 2. Place the heart shaped template over the joined squares, pin and cut out carefully.
- 3. Pin and tack to the background fabric.
- 4. Blanket stitch around the edge of the heart.
- 5. Layer backing, wadding and background.
- 6. Pin and tack.
- 7. Fold the 3" strips in half.
- 8. Pin along the edges, raw edges together. Fold over to back and sew down.
- 9. Sew a button to the corners of each square.
- 10. Stitch a message in running stitch.
