Cupcake Needle case

Materials required

9"x4 ½"(23cmx10 ½ cm wool felt for case(this has a firmer weight)

8"x4" (20cmx10cm) felt for inner

9 ½" (24cm) of buckram (one side fusible)

or pelmet Vilene

Small amounts of fabric:-

White for icing

Brown or beige for cake

Patterned for cupcake case

Bondaweb or Steam a seam for fusing fabrics

Method

- 1. Draw around each of the three shapes remembering to add the dotted line for cutting, allowing some fabric to be tucked under the piece above.
- 2. Cut shapes just outside the drawn line.
- 3. Bond to fabric (first removing the backing paper if using steam a seam).
- 4. Cut out on the line (dotted line where applicable)
- 5. Fold outer case felt in half and position cake pieces centrally, when happy with placement iron on cupcake case and remove the cake and icing. **always use baking parchment when ironing with fusibles.
- 6. Either sew with neutral thread or change top thread to match fabric. Do a trial to decide on stitch length and width.
- 7. Zig zag stitch around cupcake case leaving top unsewn.
- 8. Place cake piece on top overlapping by small amount, iron and zig zag on, leaving top where icing will cover free.
- 9. Iron on and sew icing all round.
- 10. Add a cherry either a red felt circle or button.
- 11. Bond buckram to back of work-ensure you have the fusible side covering your stitching.
- 12. Trim to size
- 13. Fold case in half mark centre and sew inner felt down the fold.
- 14. Add your favourite needles and admire.
