Christmas Stocking



## Christmas Stocking

### Materials and equipment:

You will need:

- one Christmas fabric fat quarter for the 2 outside pieces
- one fat quarter of plain fabric for 2 lining pieces
- two contrasting Christmas fabric cuff pieces 18cmx 25cm
- one 15cm piece of ribbon
- needle and thread
- pins
- paper scissors for cutting out template
- fabric scissors
- iron to press (use only with adult supervision)



### Instructions:

1. Using the main Christmas fabric, fold in half and place the stocking pattern on top, pin in place and cut out, this will give you two pieces for the front and back of the stocking.



2. Repeat above using the lining fabric.

3. Using the cuff piece, place right sides together on top of the stocking sew together using 5cm seam.

4. Repeat with the other pieces.



5. Fold the ribbon in half and pin at the top of the cuff 2cm in from the back of the stocking.

6. Place one of the lining pieces on top of the ribbon & cuff (make sure it is the same way as patterned fabric).



7. Repeat with the other side [no ribbon]

8. Place one of the 3 part pieces right sides facing up.

9. Place the remaining part right side down on top of the other piece and pin together.



10. Starting at the heel of the lining fabric sew together around the edges of the stockings and cuffs but make sure to LEAVE A GAP of approximately 10cm.



11. Clip the raw edge of the fabric on every curve.

12. Turn right sides out through the gap left.

13. Sew the gap together.

14. Push the stocking made of lining fabric into the coloured stocking by pushing the stocking toe of the lining inside and smoothing out the heel inside.

**PRESS**

15. Turn the cuff over making the top of the stocking double.



16. **PRESS**

17. The stocking is ready to be hung.
